A Messenger of God, the Prophet Micah wrote:

God calls to the city, "Listen, you people who assemble in the city. In the houses of evil men are treasures which they got dishonestly. They use false measures, a thing that I hate. How can I forgive men who use false scales and weights? Your rich men exploit the poor, and all of you are liars. So I have already begun your ruin and destruction because of your sins. You will eat, but not be satisfied, in fact you will still be hungry. You will carry things off, but you will not be able to save them; anything you do save I will destroy in war. You will sow corn, but not harvest the crop. You will press oil from olives, but never be able to use it. You will make wine, but never drink it."
